Why are we moving to one service right now?

As we've gathered in one service a few times this year so far, many have told us how much they loved the experience of being together as one church family. Through the season of Lent, we believe God has a unique journey prepared for our church leading up to Easter and we want to experience what He has for us together.

We also know that during the Easter season people are more open to attending church. As we've talked about in this teaching series, EVERYONE, we want to make it easier for anyone who is turning to God. By moving to one service and improving our experience together we hope to make it easier for anyone to invite someone to come with them to church in this season. We look forward to our guests experiencing our church as one church family and all that God has for us in this season.

How long is this for?

In conjunction with the season of Lent, we are moving to one service at 10am from March 10 – April 14. On Easter we will have 2 morning services, 9am and 10:45am. We will be inviting your feedback over these 6 weeks.

What about community?

Coffee and donuts will be available at 9:30am and after the service at 11:15. We'd love to hang out together before and after the service.

What are we doing for volunteers that serve during service?

We are so thankful for our faithful volunteers who give their time week in and week out. Over these 6 weeks we will have 3 gatherings for our volunteers at 8:30am on March 17th, March 31st and April 14th. Anyone who serves during the 10am service is welcome to come participate in this volunteer service where we'll worship together and hear the same teaching that will be given in the main service. On the other weeks the message will be available on our website and on the podcast and the volunteer huddle will be at 9:15 in the Worship Center Lobby.

We also invite everyone to participate in the other worship opportunities through the season of Lent, Ash Wednesday on March 6th, Seder Dinner on March 28th and Good Friday on April 19th.

What are we doing for small groups, Sunday school classes and labs that meet during service?

We've talked with all the group leaders and they will be discussing your adjusted group schedule with you during the season of Lent.

The relationship lab will meet from 11:15-12:30 starting March 10th.

Calvary Kids classrooms will be open for children of parents attending small groups and labs from 11:15am – 12:30pm.

What are the students going to do?

Students (Middle School and High School) are going to meet at 11:15am on Sundays to allow students the opportunity to continue serving and attending church. Students will continue to join the Worship Center service as a group on the first Sunday of the month to participate in the service and take communion together.

What is happening with Traditional Service?

We have heard from some who attend the Traditional Service that it is physically difficult to attend services in the Worship Center and they better resonate with the traditional worship style of music. For these 6 weeks Traditional Service will meet at 10am in the Chapel to align with the video teaching and still enjoy the traditional style music.

Calvary Kids will continue to offer the same awesome classroom experience for kids infant – 5th grade during the 10am service. Classrooms open at 9:45, so grab a donut in the Worship Center lobby at 9:30 and head over to check them in!

Shining Stars, our classroom for children with special needs, will also be open during the 10am service and offer the same great care for our kids as always.
