DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Upper Elementary - HSM

What does God say to Moses in verses 5-6?
Why do you think he says this?
Why do you think Moses is afraid to look at God?
What does God ask Moses to do in verses 10-12?
What promises does God make in verses 19-22?
What does this passage teach us about God?
How does knowing this affect your relationship with God?

Preschool - 3rd Grade

In the beginning of this story why did God's people cry out to God? (Were they happy, sad, or afraid?)
When the people cried out to God, did He hear them?
What did God do to help His people?
What happened to the bush that was on fire?
What did God ask Moses to do (from the bush)?
Was Moses happy, sad, or afraid?
Who helped Moses even though he was afraid?
Who can help you when you're afraid?

MEMORY VERSE

Upper Elementary - HSM

Proverbs 3:5-6
Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and lean not on your own understanding; In all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight.

Preschool-K's verse (same as 1st-12th graders; just shortened to help them learn with hand motions):
Trust the Lord (*point both index fingers straight up in the air*) with all (*stretch your arms out wide*) your heart (*bring both hands together over your heart*), Proverbs 3:5 (*open your hands like a book*).
